



Our primary phase pupils really shone and showed their individual abilities, effort and tried new things as part of their sports afternoon in groups out on the field


Year 7, 8 and 9 pupils really pushed themselves to achieve and compete with each other during the Key Stage 3 sports afternoon



Year 10 and 11 pupils excelled themselves and showed excellent sportsmanship and skills across a range of challenges


